

Mastering Technical Requirements

In order to provide the best mastering service to our customers, we have provided information to assist with file preparation and delivery so that the process is as seamless as possible.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

To get the best possible result the following conditions are helpful:

- Sample rate: 44.1, 48, or 96Khz (the higher the better)
- Audio bit rate: 16 or 24 bit (the higher the better)
- Audio format: uncompressed files including WAV, AIFF, PCM (no MP3!)
- Try to not exceed -6 dBFS peak on a peak meter on the highest peak of the mix.
- Do not use compression or limiting on your master buss when exporting
- Do not apply any stereo imaging to the master buss when exporting

UPLOADING INSTRUCTIONS

For convenience, we suggest sending your mixed stereo tracks through our preferred file transfer website Wetransfer.com. Follow the instructions below to upload your files:

1 Go to <u>https://www.wetransfer.com/</u> Type in your email in the "Your email" field, Type in <u>info@waysound.com</u> in the "Friend's email" field and include any additional instructions in the "Message" field.

2 Attach files individually, or zip them together. The total file size cannot exceed 2GB per upload. If your files are larger than 2GB, split the files into a few uploads and label them as such: UPLOAD_1of2, UPLOAD_2of2, ect...

When mastered files are completed, you will be notified via email and the finished product will be delivered in the requested format by the client.
